Providence Cedars-Sinai Tarzana Medical Center (PCSTMC) is a non-profit community hospital with 250 licensed beds that has been serving the San Fernando Valley communities since 1973. In addition to heart, vascular, orthopedic, cancer, pediatric and women's services, we house the largest Level III Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) in the area and our emergency department has been designated by the Los Angeles County Department of Health as a STEMI and stroke receiving center. The pharmacy department provides 24-hour care and offers a broad range of clinical services including, Antimicrobial stewardship, TPN & pharmacokinetic consults,, anticoagulation safety, and Transition of Care activities.

Pharmacy Residency Program Objectives

The PGY1 Acute Care Pharmacy Residency Program is designed to develop practitioner excellence in the provision of patient-centered, evidence-based care. Our philosophy is to continually advance and pioneer the pharmacy profession with a wide variety of clinical responsibilities and duties performed daily by our pharmacy staff to improve patient care.

Pharmacy Residency Program Features

Accredited by ASHP since 2007, the PGY1 Pharmacy Residency Program emphasizes the development of clinical, operational, administrative, teaching, and leadership abilities. Our program is designed to prepare a motivated, self-directed individual to become a confident and competent clinical pharmacist in an acute care setting and able to pursue PGY2 residency training. We are committed to providing an environment with advanced education and training experiences.

Compensation and Benefits

Compensation for the first year of residency is approximately \$60,000. Benefits include full medical, dental and vision coverage as well as 14 days of vacation. Resident accommodations include their own work area and travel and registration reimbursements for residency-related conferences.

Residency Requirements

The resident must possess a Doctor of Pharmacy degree from an accredited college of pharmacy and have a California intern license prior to beginning the program on July 1. It is expected that the resident will be a licensed pharmacist in the state of California before September 2 of the residency year).

The residents' schedule will include a 40-hour workweek that includes two weekends a month. There is an opportunity to staff once adequately trained. The residents will also participate in activities necessary for maintaining accreditation. Residents will also be expected to precept fourth year APPE students and attend interdisciplinary rounds.

How to Apply

Providence Tarzana Medical Center participates in the ASHP PhORCAS and the ASHP MATCH program.. Applicants must submit all application documents below through PhORCAS before January 2:

- Letter of intent including the following:
 - How will PCSTMC's residency program help further your professional goals?
 - As a prospective resident, how can you contribute to PCSTMC's program?
- Official transcripts from your school of pharmacy
- Curriculum Vitae
- Three letters of recommendation (at least one from a faculty member and one from employer)
- Upload a recent photograph

Personal interviews will be scheduled from the end of January through February.
