### Curriculum

- Includes protected, focused training time to gain foundational skills and knowledge
- Virtual training sessions, independent training, and leadership development webinars on the following topics and others:

The DNS In-Training Program is a 6month position. During the program, you will learn the skills needed to become a DNS in your own right while receiving onthe-job training and guidance from a dedicated mentor, preceptor and others within the larger organization.

- Five years nursing experience required
- Must be willing to relocate post-training for business needs
- Currently holds an unencumbered RN license
