### **Practicum Pre-requisites**

- Completion of Junior year of bachelor's level degree
- Coursework (a minimum of 4 college level courses) in the related fields of child life such as family studies, child/human development, education, etc.
- A minimum of 100 hours of practical experience with children from infants through adolescent (examples: nanny, babysitting, early childhood education, and the like)

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## **Sanford Children's Hospital Child Life Practicum Experience**

### **Practicum Format:**

The Sanford Children's Child Life Practicum is designed as an introductory experience for individuals interested in pursuing a career in child life. Through experiential learning and observation of Certified Child Life Specialists, Child Life practicum students begin to increase their knowledge of evidence-based, developmentally-appropriate interventions including therapeutic play, preparation and education that support and reduce fear, anxiety and pain for infants, children, youth and families as they cope with the stress and uncertainty of illness, injury and treatment. Through these experiences, child life practicum students will enhance their knowledge of the child life profession and investigate the process of applying child life and developmental theory to practice.

### **Practicum Dates:**

- ***Minimum of 100 hours/Maximum of 120 hours equivalent to 3-4 week time period.***
- ***Minimum commitment of 30 hours per week. Can be scheduled up to 40 hours a week.***  
Hours can be scheduled Monday-Sunday, scheduled by Child Life Manager.
- Practicum experience will be offered in the summer of 2024 ***(May 13 – June 7).***

### **Practicum objectives:**

- Become familiar with the child life profession.
- Recognize reactions to stress, illness, and pain in children from infancy through adolescence and family members.
- Observe and learn communication skills with children from infancy through adolescence and family members in the healthcare setting.
- Understand the importance of establishing and maintaining therapeutic relationships with patients and families.
- Recognize the value of play and psychosocially supportive interventions.
- Identify ways to integrate theoretical developmental knowledge with practice.

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### **Expectations:**

- Written goals for practicum experience.
- Observation and supervised participation in all program areas.
- Daily journal of experience, including track record of procedures observed.
- Participate in discussion with supervising staff re: observations and insights.
- Completion of assigned readings/write one-two paragraphs summarizing article/reading.
- End of experience summary of how practicum experience has enhanced knowledge of child life practice and readied student for pursuit of the child life internship and profession.
- Conduct self in a professional manner (appearance, punctuality, flexibility, etc.)
